iii. Personal Protective Equipment:

- a. Hospital Management reported that they have sufficient supplies of PPE for staff and expects more to arrive i.e.
- Masks (Surgical & N95)
- Gloves
- Gowns etc.
- Management further reports that it is difficult to issue PPE to patients due to their mental status. (This has been highlighted as a potential risk that could increase the spread of COVID-19)
- c. A few patients are adhering and do wear masks

iv. Social Distancing:

- Staff adheres to social distancing protocols at all times
- Few patients capable of understanding and adhering to social distancing

6. COVID-19 Screening & Testing:

- No social visit to patients or staff is allowed
- Daily screening for all staff and official visitors before entrance to Facility. Any person with abnormal temperature is denied entrance, and staff are referred for testing
- No Mask No Entry Protocol applied
- Temperature of all patients are taken 4 hourly
- Staff recommended to test private as turnaround time is faster
- Most patients are tested with assistance of Kouga Health SD staff

13. COVID-19 Containment Measures:

- All patients and staff administered flu vaccine
- Only 1 staff member refused (Index Case)
- All patients admitted are tested for COVID-19
- All in-patients showing COVID-19 Symptoms are tested
- All confirmed cases are daily monitored for symptoms using **COVID-19 Symptoms Monitoring Tool**

14. COMMENTS AND OTHER INTERVENTIONS:

- Life Esidimeni management to join Local and District JOC
- Daily reporting on Screening and Testing to District office
- Department has met Kirkwood Life Care Centre management on 2 occasions this week to address the abnormal spike in Cases in the Centre.
- Issues Identified, to be addressed:
 - 1. Ouarantine of clients after test. Centre has rented the Tennis Court Hall to isolate cases there.
 - 2. Unit 7 identified as epicenter in Centre. Up and about patients to be separated from bedridden patients. Fumigation of Wards a huge challenge. Deep cleaning done and ward is monitored constantly
 - 3. Challenge with patients wearing PPE, adhering to social distance and hand washing protocol. Will address issue again with Occupational Therapists to teach patients on these protocols
 - 4. Recommendation on cards to test ALL occupants (633) Patients, 139 Staff) and isolate based on status.

Provincial Visit (29 May 2020)

- On 29 May 2020 the Centre had a visit from the Provincial Epidemiology unit, Mr. Thomas Dlamini and Team
- The Province were to report to SG on their assessment and recommendation on the visit.
- The Centre also informed us that they expect a visit from their Head Office during the week of 1 - 5 June 2020
